Holiday Projects

- Work in small groups- 10 approx
- Each group has a member of staff and a small support team
- The support team is made up of members of our Youth Theatre or students who are on training programmes
- Additional staff that manage and lead the workshops
- The days are broken down into short activities. Finishing with a performance on Friday afternoon
- Can book via our Box office or online
- Free places by referral only




Additional Information



- Staffing ratio is 1 10, however due to support team the ratio of support generally is much higher e.g. 1-4.
- All children will get the support that they need within an inclusive environment. Individual support is given where needed.
- Personal Care- Discuss needs with parent/carer and if appropriate child/young person, joint decision on who will provide this
- Our child based activities are not Ofsted registered
- We have a safeguarding policy and all staff are DBS'd. Staff have been trained in safeguarding and Health and Safety
- As an educational establishment and Youth Organisation we have polices in place that protect children and young people and are legally required
