

EMOTIONAL WELLBEING AND YOUR CHILD EVENT FEEDBACK

OVERVIEW

32 parent carers attended the event (plus 6 from the Our Voice team) out of 58 who originally registered. 18 attendees completed feedback forms.

Of those completing the forms, 67% had never attended an Our Voice event for parent carers before. This is an unusually high figure for our events suggesting the broad appeal of the topic.

As would be expected from the topic of the event, all felt that their children struggled with their emotional well-being with 22% frequently struggling severely and 45% struggling quite often.

The event was positively received. Of those responding:

- 95% rated the panel session as excellent or very good (and the remainder as good)
- 86% rated the workshop as excellent or very good (and the remainder as good)
- 100% rated their 1:1 appointments as excellent or very good
- 72% said that after attending the event they felt better informed about tools and sources of information and support to help with supporting their child's emotional wellbeing, and 22% said they felt better informed 'to some extent'

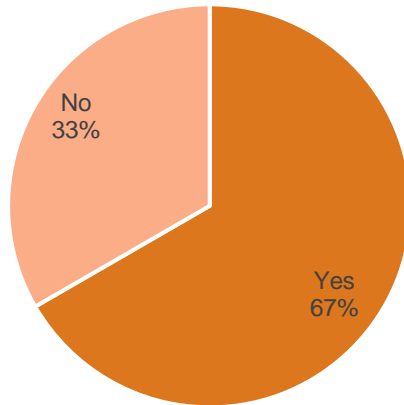

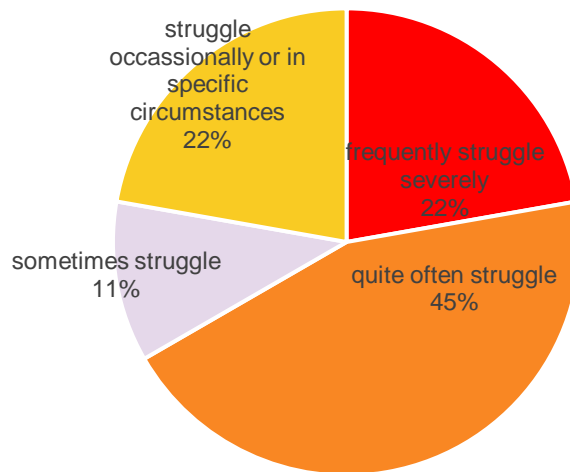
There were no negative comments other than some practical points about sound quality, which we are following up with the venue.

Is this the first Our Voice event for parents and carers that you have attended?

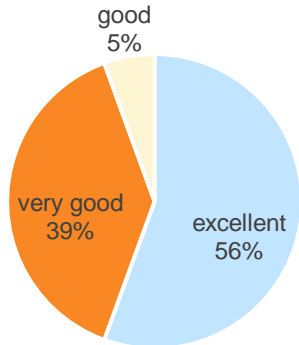


To what extent does your child struggle with their emotional wellbeing?

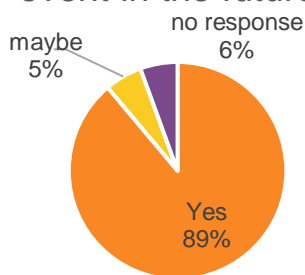
Rating of panel session



Rating of workshop (of 14 responses)



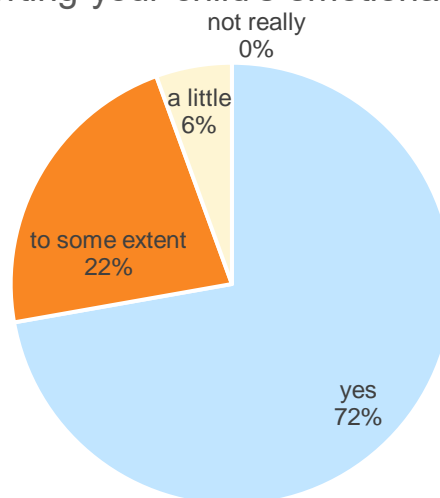
Would you come to a similar event in the future?



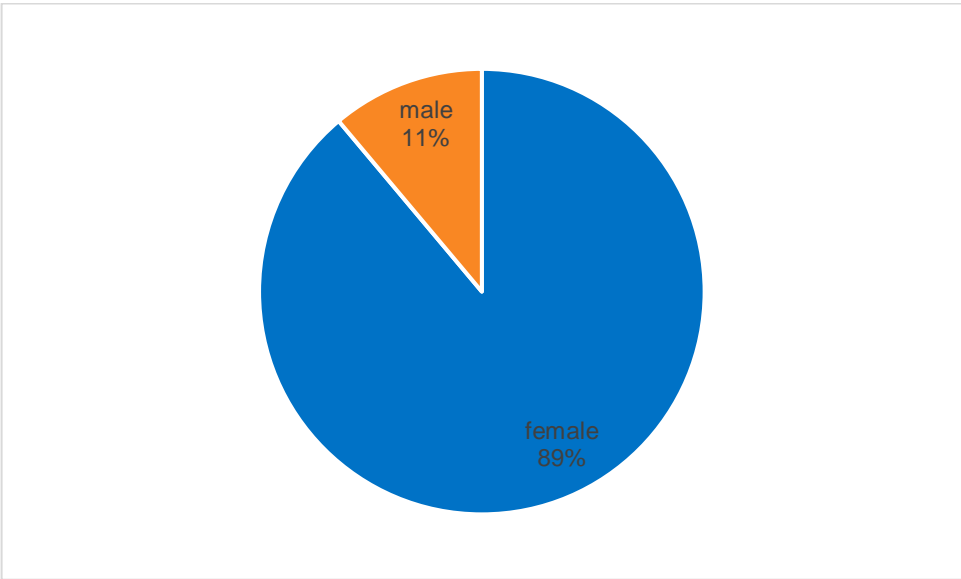
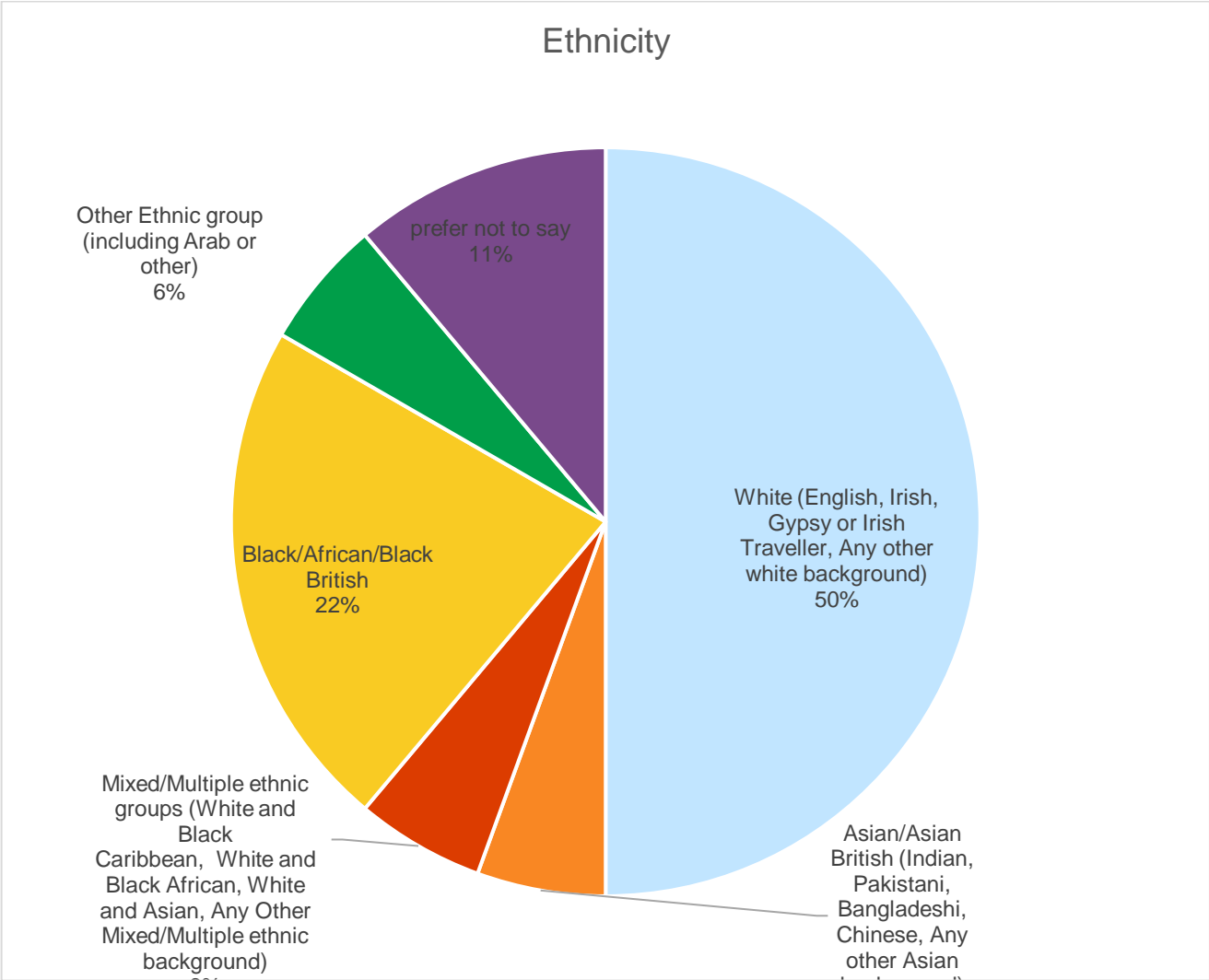
Rating of 1:1 (10 responses)
